***NEW* Now accepting** even more of your old electronics. Starting today April 1, 2010, VCR's, DVD's, stereos and cameras can now be dropped off at Sarcan depots. The Saskatchewan Waste Electronic Equipment program or "Sweep" has expanded. It already takes in computers, televisions and printers. The equipment is dismantled and the materials re-used. So far, they have made about 12-million pounds of difference in three years since the program started... materials that they have kept out of Saskatchewan landfills or from being shipped offshore. So they are making a very significant difference.

WOODLAWN CEMETERY

The City of Meadow Lake will be doing maintenance at the Woodlawn Cemetery from May 3 – May 12. The Cemetery Bylaw states the following:

“The Town shall have the right to remove all flowers and wreaths, natural or artificial, from any grave thirty days after their placement thereon.

The Administrator may remove or prevent the placing of any stand, holder, base or other receptacle for flowers or plants deemed to be unsuitable and a hindrance to the maintenance of the Cemetery.”

This includes ornaments, toys, solar lighting, or any item that will interfere with general ground maintenance such as mowing.

If you wish to keep items you have placed on the grave site please pick them up before, Monday May 3 or they will be removed.

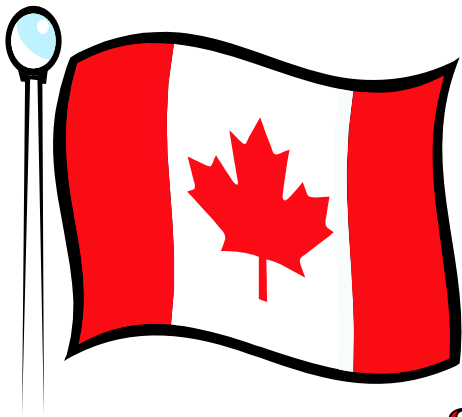
