WATER SAVING TIPS

There are many ways to reduce water use around your home:

- Install low-flow fixtures, such as high-efficiency shower heads and low-flush toilets.
- Shorten your shower time and reduce the level of water when bathing.
- Fix leaks as soon as you notice them. Fixing leaks could save you about 10 percent on your water bill.
- Wash your car at the car wash
- Use a broom when cleaning your driveway or walkway instead of a hose.



CONSERVING WATER DURING LAWN CARE

Spring is upon us which means gardening and lawn care season is almost here. With this typically comes with an increase in your water usage. Here are some tips and tricks you can use to help conserve water:

Avoid watering during the heat of the day or during windy times to minimize evaporation.

Set a tuna can in each of your sprinkler zones and time how long it takes to fill it with water. That's how long you should run your sprinkler once a week if your lawn is dry.

Ensure your sprinklers are working properly and are targeted away from sidewalks. Collect rain water. Rain water contains minerals and nutrients that are good for plants.

Using rain barrels also diverts water away from the City's storm sewer system. Be sure that rain barrels are properly covered to discourage mosquito larvae from developing.

Did you know?
Water use can increase by as much as 50% during the growing season?



SAVE ENERGY

A significant amount of energy is required to treat, distribute, and manage our water and wastewater. By reducing your water consumption, you help conserve energy, reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and help ease the burden on our water and wastewater treatment plants and distribution systems.

COMPOSTING SEASON

Did you know Protex Enviro runs a yard waste composting program from May to October for un-bagged leaves, un-bagged grass clippings and non-woody vegetation?

- 1 Account number. Used on forms or for payments to connect them to your utility account.
- 2 Physical address of property.
- 3 Date the bills are generated.
- 4 The start & end date of the billing cycle.
- 5 This is the current balance on your account on the date the bills are generated or "balance forward"
- 6 Garbage and recycling is charged per bin.
- 7 Sewer consumption is calculated at 40% of the water consumption rate.
- 8 Base Water & Sewer fees goes towards the day-to-day operating costs of providing water and sewer services. This does not include your water usage.
- 9 The metered water charge takes how much water that was used in this quarter (consumption) and multiplies it by the consumption rate. The current reading can be compared to your water meter to check the bill for accuracy.
- 10 The infrastructure fee goes towards infrastructure upgrades, improvements, and replacements.
- 11 The total amount billed for this quarter. Does not include the forwarding balance.
- 12 Total balance owing on the account as of the day the bills are generated. Current levy plus the forwarding balance.
