## UTILITY E-BILLING

Sign up for e-billing! This helps save paper and also gets your bill to you up to a week sooner than bills sent out by regular mail. ## FROZEN SERVICE LINES

Section 42 of the Water and Sewer Bylaw states that city residents are entitled to one free thaw once per year.

To prevent repeated freezing, the City may authorize or instruct the property owner to connect an approved "bleeder" line or open an approved tap.

If you experience frozen service lines, you will need to contact a plumber to determine the cause and fix the problem.

## NEW WATER & SEWER RATES 2026

Quarterly utility rates will increase on January 1, 2026 with the change first appearing on the March 31st bill.

## SUSPECT A LEAK?

1. Turn off all taps, and ensure any appliances that use water are not running.
2. Check your water meter (usually found in your basement or crawl space) write down the number or take a picture.
3. Wait an hour or two and check the meter again. If the number has increased something is leaking.

Did you know?

That if you have a leak, you may be eligible for a one time consumption adjustment on your utility bill?

If you are experiencing a leak, contact a plumber to troubleshoot and repair.

## Remember:

- Collection equipment requires clear, safe access to your carts
- Containers must be placed at least 4 feet away from any buildings, vehicles, other carts overhead and underground utilities
- Containers with inappropriate materials, or is overweight or overloaded will be bypassed by collection personnel
- When recycling, break down any cardboard and rinse containers and cans before putting in the bin. Do not bag or tie up recycling.
